

What have we been learning?

Week beginning: 22nd April 2024

This week in maths we have been learning to count by adding on. We have been playing a game racing our partner to get to 20. We also have a cheeky kangaroo in our class who keeps messing up our number lines—and we have to keep sorting them out!



In RE this week, we have been learning about the festival of Pentecost, which is on the 19th May. We learned that after Easter, when he spent 40 days with his disciples, Jesus went back to heaven, and that he promised to send a new friend to help people—the Holy Spirit. We learned that the disciples received the Good News that Jesus had kept his promise, when they felt the Holy Spirit in the room with them. We acted out the story together. We also went to visit Father Tom in church to see the Easter Garden.

We have been learning all about busy bees this week. Ask your child some facts about bees.

- ⇒ How many wings do they have?
- ⇒ How many legs do they have?
- ⇒ Is a bee an insect?
- ⇒ How do bees make honey?
- ⇒ Do all bees make honey?



How can you help your child with their learning?

- Help your child to count by adding on, you can play a game with them at home that involves using a dice - for example if they are on number 6 and they roll a 5—they need to count on 5 spaces to get to 11. We are focussing on numbers to 20.
- Please carry on reading with your child every day, for at least 15 minutes. This is the best thing that you can do to help your child with their learning. Thank you for your help with this :)
