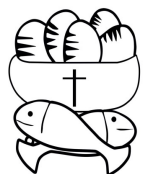
Do you have any questions about school life?

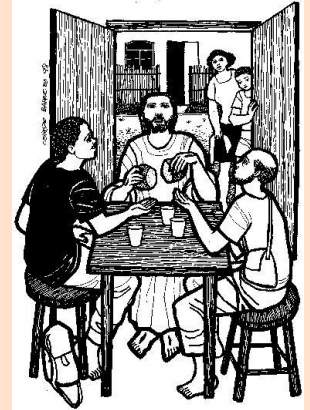
