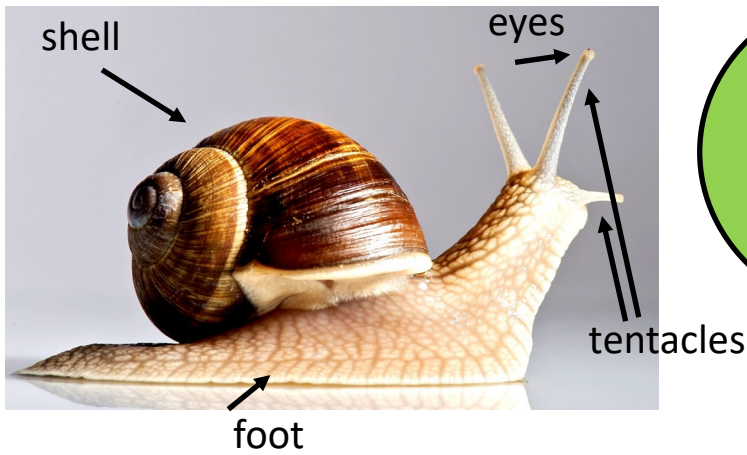


What have we been learning?

Week beginning: 15th April 2024

Our new topic is Minibeasts. We have spent all week learning lots of facts about slimy snails! Ask your child to tell you some facts about snails :)



Snails can't see very well, so they have tentacles to feel and help them to know where they are going.



In RE, our new topic is good news. We have been discussing what good news is, and talking about how we feel when we have good news to share.

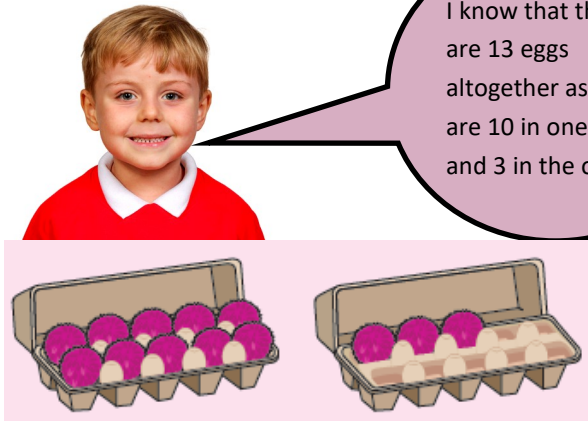
My good news is that my mummy is having a baby!

My good news is that I have just moved house!



In maths we are beginning to learn about numbers to 20. We have been focussing on numbers to 13 this week. We are learning to become more familiar with numbers beyond 10, and the pattern of numbers to 20 and beyond. We have been speaking about what numbers are 1 more or 1 less than a number between 10-13. We have also been adding 10 and 1, 10 and 2, and 10 and 3.

I know that there are 13 eggs altogether as there are 10 in one box and 3 in the other.



How can you help your child with their learning?

- Our new topic this term is Minibeasts. A minibeast is a small animal e.g. an insect or a spider. This week we have been learning all about slimy snails. Speak to your child about different types of minibeasts when you are walking around— help your child identify them and talk about them :)
- In RE our new topic is good news. Help your child to identify what 'good news' is by talking to them about events in their own life e.g. their cousin is having a baby, their uncle is getting married, Jesus has risen from the dead.
