Thank you to our wonderful musicians and singers for performing so well this week.

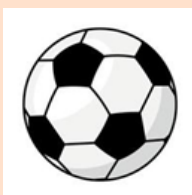

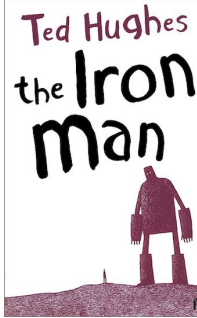
Work of the week...
