

What have we been learning?

Week beginning: 22nd January 2024

In maths this week we have been learning about capacity. We have been using the words full, empty, nearly full, and nearly empty. We have been practising pouring the right amount of water into our containers. We have also been comparing containers, predicting which one would hold the most, and which one would hold the least. We then used a jug to measure how many jugs of water each container holds so that we could find out the answer.



In RE we have been learning about the story of The Presentation of Jesus at the temple. We learnt that Mary and Joseph took the Baby Jesus to the temple to introduce him to the community. At the temple, they met Anna and Simeon- an old, wise man. Simeon said that Jesus was like a light to help people. Anna was delighted to meet Jesus and gave thanks to God for him. We used drama to help us learn and think about this Bible story.



How can you help your child with their learning?

- Help your child to learn to read their high frequency words by doing the 'look, cover, write, check' work in their homework pack. Quick recognition of these words helps your child be able to read books fluently. Thank you for your help with this.
- Help your child to add 2 small groups of objects together (e.g $1+1=2$, $3+1=4$). For example – I have 3 pebbles here, and 2 pebbles here, how many pebbles do I have altogether? Show them that if you count all of these objects, they have 5 altogether. Ask them 'How can I make 4? How can I make 5?'
