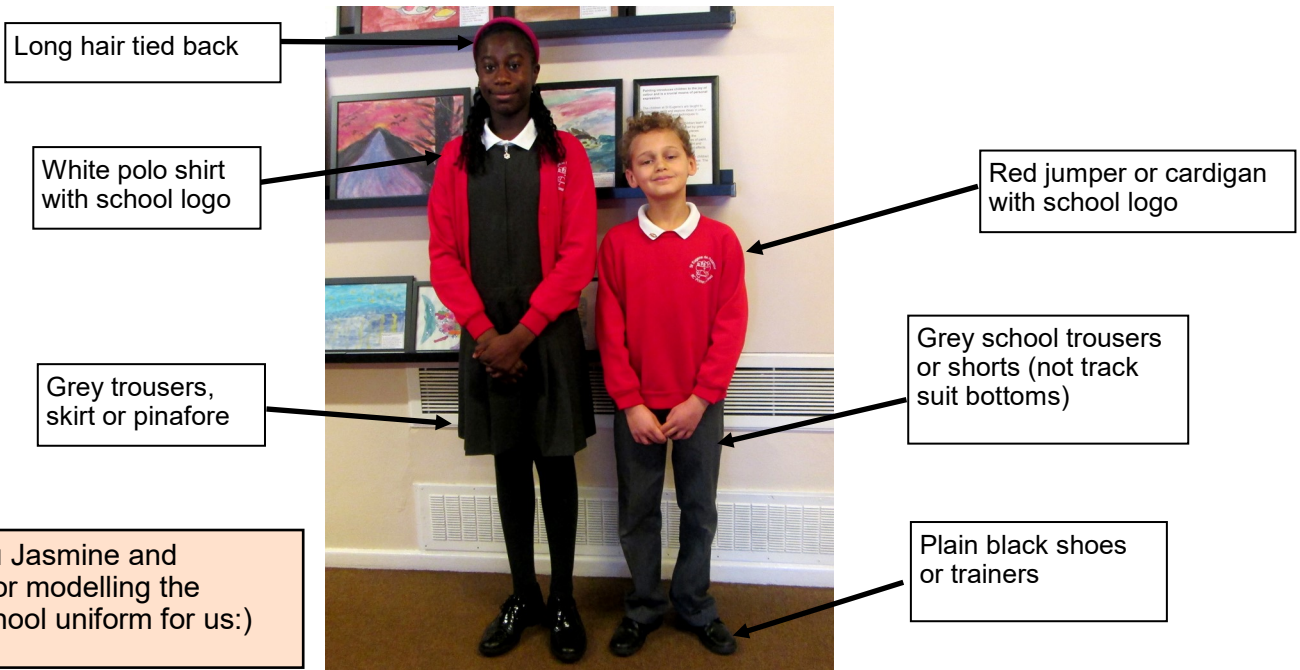

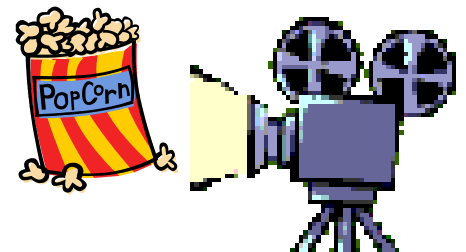


Thank-you Jasmine and Edouard for modelling the correct school uniform for us:)
