We teach the children about the difference between teasing and one off incidents of someone "being rude, or mean" and bullying. Do come and meet with your child's teacher if you have any questions about this.

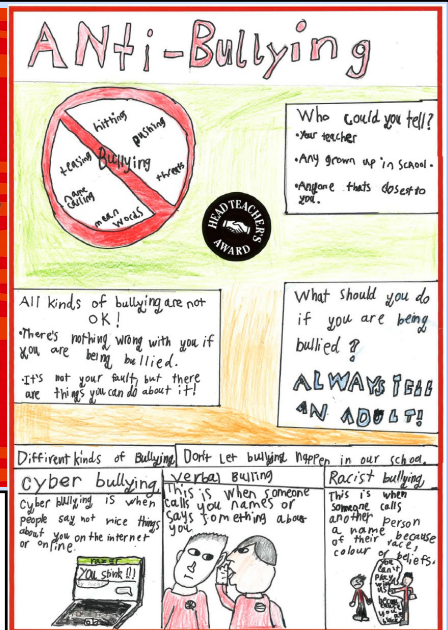
