

What have we been learning?

Week beginning: 13th November 2023

This week we have been learning all about circles and triangles. We have discussing different ways to identify each shape. We have learned that a circle only has 1 curved side, and a triangle must have 3 straight sides and 3 corners. We went on a shape hunt around school to find circles and triangles, but we also had a look for squares too. During choosing time we have been making shape pictures inspired by the artist Kandinsky.



On Monday we went to the church to see Father Terry. Father Terry baptised our class baby, Star. This was a very special celebration, as Star has now joined us in God's family.



How can you help your child with their learning?

- In phonics this week we have been learning the digraphs (sounds with 2 letters) 'sh', 'ch', 'th', 'nk' and 'ng'. Please practise saying, reading and writing sounds that your child has learned with them and help them with their letter formation, ensuring they are holding their pencils correctly and starting the letters in the right place :)
