

What have we been learning?

Week beginning: 9th October 2023

This week in maths we have been learning to compare size and capacity. We had 2 teddies, one large and one small. We had to decide which plate, cutlery set, cup, and portion of food to give each bear. We then discussed what full, empty, half full and nearly empty meant—and poured the bears some water for their dinner. We have also been comparing groups of items using the words 'more and 'fewer' for example—this book has more votes than the other book. This book is the winner because 15 is more than 10.



In music we have been singing lots of lovely songs and learning to use some African drums—it has been very fun!



How can you help your child with their learning?

- In phonics this week we have been learning the sounds o, c, k, u, and b. Attached to this newsletter is a sheet with our handwriting rhymes, which is how the children are taught to write their sounds. Please practise saying, reading and writing sounds that your child has learned with them and help them with their letter formation, ensuring they are holding their pencils correctly :)
