

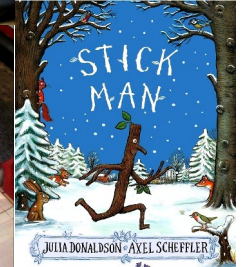
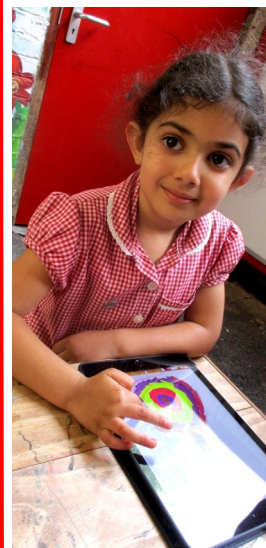
What have we been learning?

Week beginning: 5th May 2025

This week in maths we have been learning to count by adding on. We have been playing a game racing our partner to get to 20. We also have a cheeky kangaroo in our class who keeps messing up our number lines—and we have to keep sorting them out!



On Wednesday we had a visit from the Camden Learning Centre. We learned how to use an application called 'Chatterpix' to add our voices and retell our favourite parts of the story 'The Stick Man'. We also got to draw our own pictures of the stick man on the tablets. We had lots of fun!



We have been learning all about spinning spiders this week. Ask your child some facts about spiders.

- ⇒ How many legs do they have?
- ⇒ What is a baby spider called?
- ⇒ How do spiders catch their food?
- ⇒ Where is a spider's home?



How can you help your child with their learning?

- Please keep helping your child with their letter formation homework. It is important that they start at the top of the letter, their letters are neat, facing the right way, and sitting in the right place on the line. If they do not follow the way they have been taught to form the letter, they will find it trickier to write letter neatly when they join up their handwriting in the future. Thank you for your help with this :)
- Play a board game (using a dice) with your child. This helps your child to recognise dot patterns quickly without counting (subitising) and helps them with many other skills, such as taking turns, and winning/losing graciously!
