Sports Day was lots of fun!

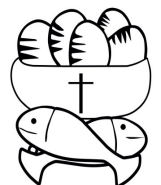

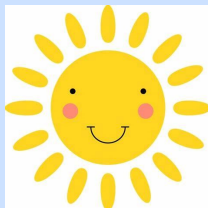

*We listened to the Gospel of Luke*

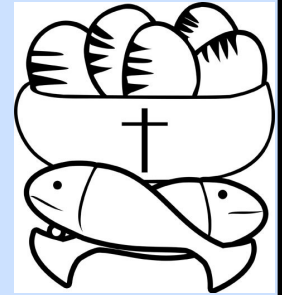


Father of us all,
