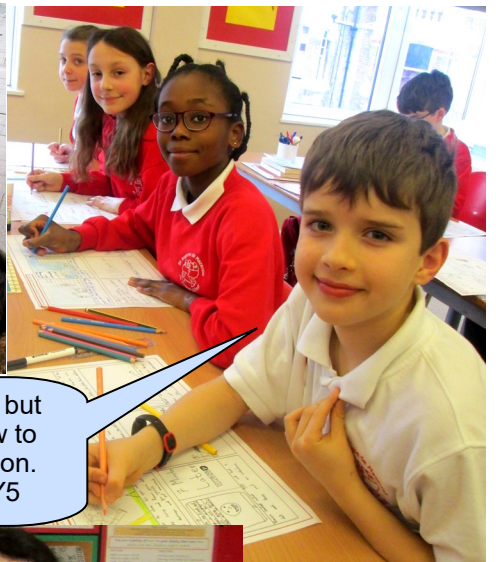

I know that this means not to park outside our school so that children can cross the road safely with their parents. I know I should hold my Mum's hand. Max Y2

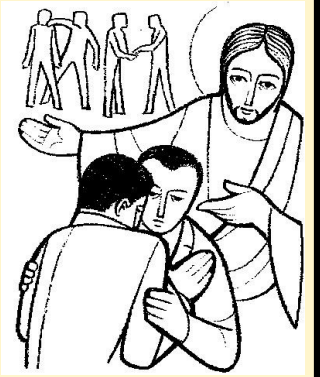
