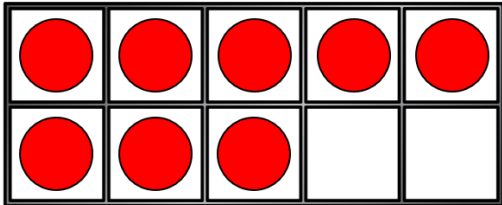


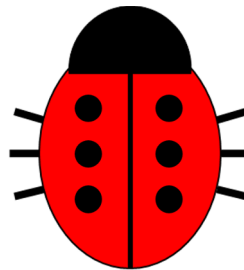
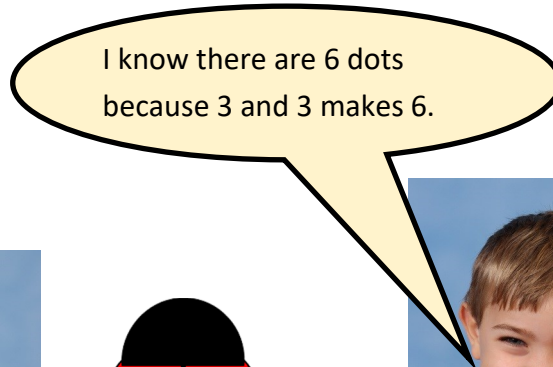
What have we been learning?

In maths this week we have been learning about the numbers 6, 7, and 8. We have been learning how to make those numbers- e.g. $3+3=6$, $4+2=6$, $5+1=6$. We have also been learning to subitise these numbers, which means to recognise them without counting. We have also been discussing what is one more and one less than these numbers.



I know there are 8 counters because 5 and 3 make 8.
