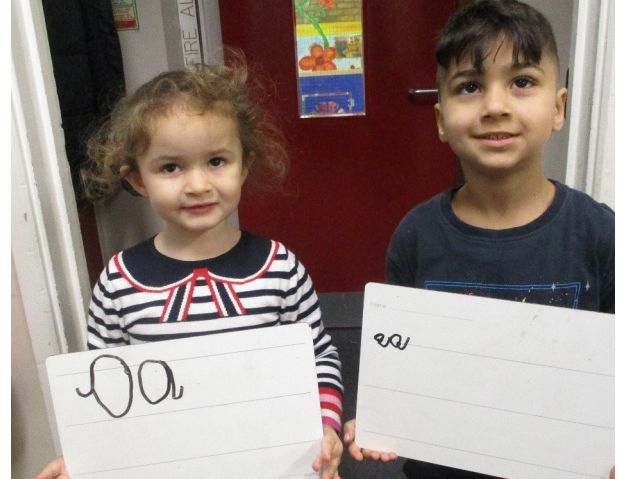
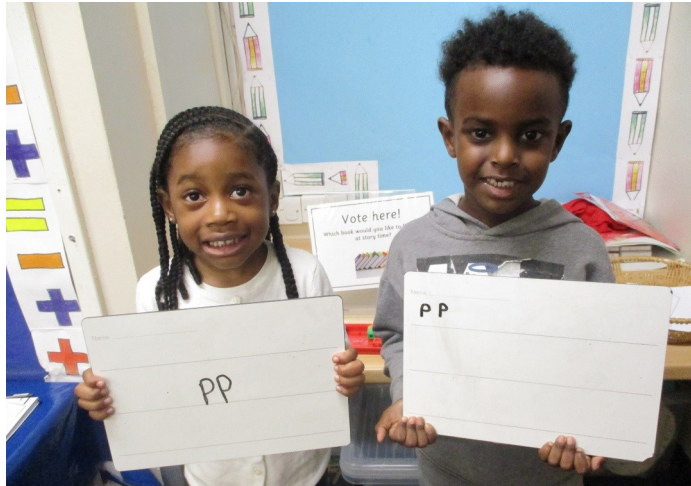


What have we been learning?

Week beginning: 22nd September 2025

This week we have started our phonics lessons, which is the beginning of being able to read. We have learned the sounds 's', 'a', 't' and 'p.' Over the next few weeks we will learn all of our letter sounds and how to write them, and then we will learn how to blend the sounds together to read words. We have all been working very hard!



In RE this week, we learned all about the Bible. We learned that the Bible is a special book for Christians. It helps them learn about God and how to live kindly. We learned that we must treat Bibles with respect, and make sure that we are careful with them. We learned that we keep the Bible in a special place. The Bible has stories about Jesus and stories Jesus told.



How can you help your child with their learning?

- Help your child to recognise their name, and practise writing their name. Make sure they begin with a capital letter, but all other letters are lower case.
- Your child has brought home some flashcards – cut them up and use them at home to help practise the high frequency words (these are the words which appear most often in books). Your child needs to be able to read them, spell them and use them in a sentence . Knowing these words by sight enables your child to know 25% of words in all books. Reading is the most important thing you can do to help your child's learning. Thank you for your help with this :)
