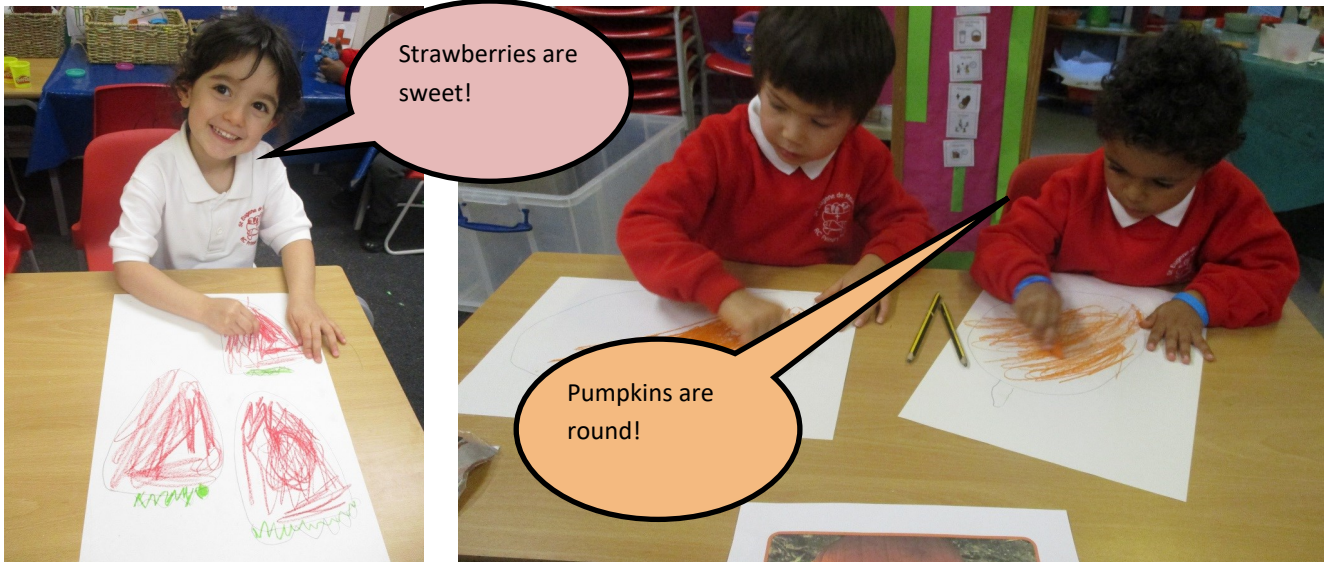


What have we been learning?

We have been working hard on our drawings of fruit and vegetables for our Harvest Festival assembly :) We drew the outlines, then coloured in the pictures with oil pastels. We have been learning that harvest festival is a special time of year, when we appreciate that our food has been safely harvested, and we thank God that we have food, as not everyone is so fortunate.
