

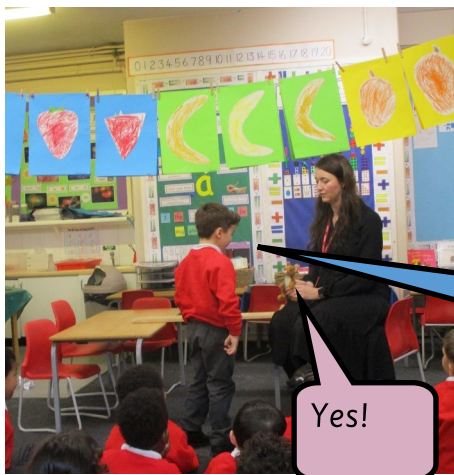
What have we been learning?

Week beginning: 3rd November 2025

This week we have been learning about equality and fairness. We have been learning to understand that we are all different and that we are all equally valuable in the world—no matter whether we are a boy or girl. We have been talking about everyone being able to play with any toys or dressing up outfits that they would like. We also thought about the sorts of jobs we could do as adults, for example a girl might grow up to be a firefighter, a boy might be a nurse.



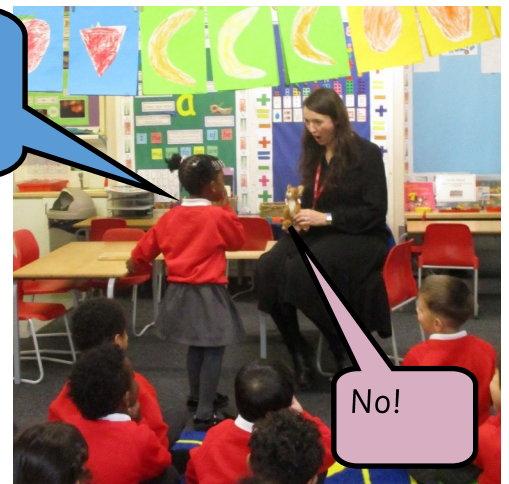

When asked to describe how it made them feel, the children said that they felt sad, and angry, and that the kangaroo was being 'unfair' and 'mean'.
