

What have we been learning?

Week beginning: 27th April 2026

We have been learning all about busy bees this week.

Ask your child some facts about bees.

- ⇒ How many wings do they have?
- ⇒ How many legs do they have?
- ⇒ Is a bee an insect?
- ⇒ How do bees make honey?
- ⇒ Do all bees make honey?

Bees help to make new flowers grow.



In maths we are beginning to learn about numbers to 20. We have been focussing on numbers to 13 this week. We are learning to become more familiar with numbers beyond 10, and the pattern of numbers to 20 and beyond. We have been speaking about what numbers are 1 more or 1 less than a number between 10-13. We have also been adding 10 and 1, 10 and 2, and 10 and 3.



I know that there are 13 eggs altogether as there are 10 in one box and 3 in the other.

We made 12, 13, and 14 with the numberblocks!



How can you help your child with their learning?

- Help your child to count by adding on, you can play a game with them at home that involves using a dice - for example if they are on number 6 and they roll a 5—they need to count on 5 spaces to get to 11. We are focussing on numbers to 20.
- Please carry on reading with your child every day, for at least 15 minutes. This is the best thing that you can do to help your child with their learning. Thank you for your help with this :)
