Year 4 Hampstead Heath trip

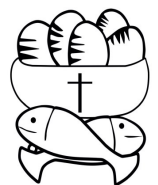
The Year 4 children had a lovely time on their trip last week. They explored lots of different environments on the Heath where mini beasts might be hiding including pond dipping.

Work of the week...

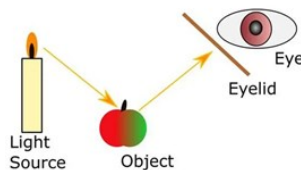
Every week a fantastic piece of children's work is showcased in the school lobby (next to the office).
