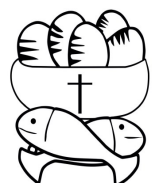
It was the best trip ever and I really enjoyed it!

Each week the class with the very best attendance are celebrated in our assembly. This week our attendance champions were: **Year 6 with 97%. Well done Year 6!**



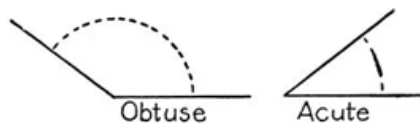
## Work of the week...
