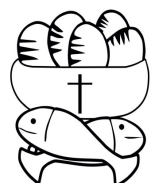
Summer Music Concert

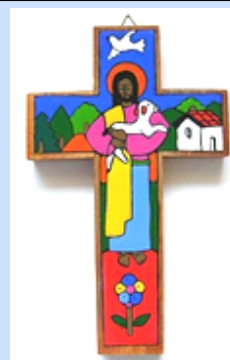
