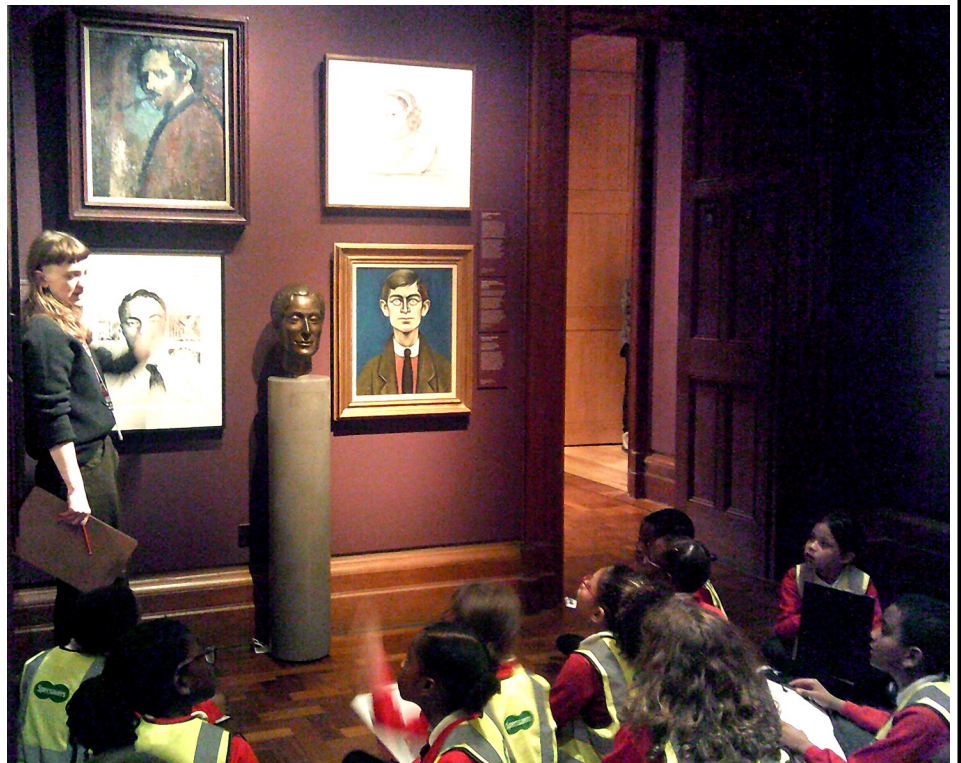
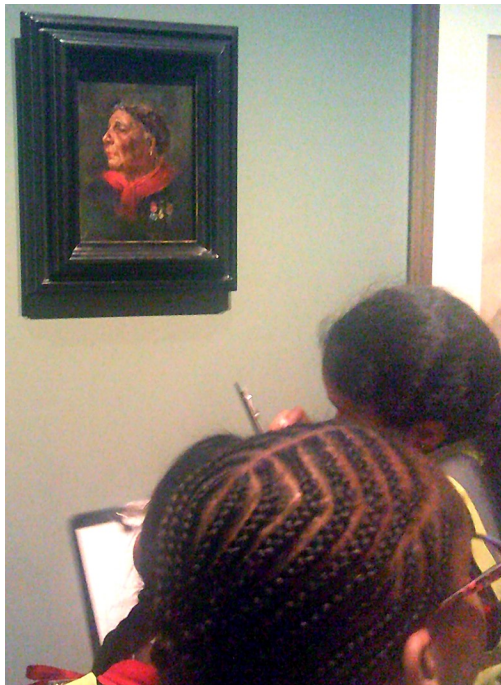
Our Christmas events are coming up! Do take a look at the calendar overleaf and pop the dates into your diary. It is lovely to share the Christmas spirit with our families and community.

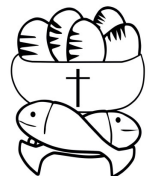
Do you have any questions about school life?

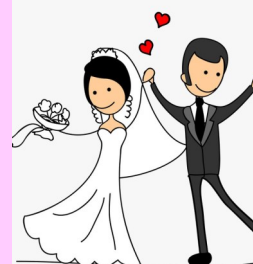
