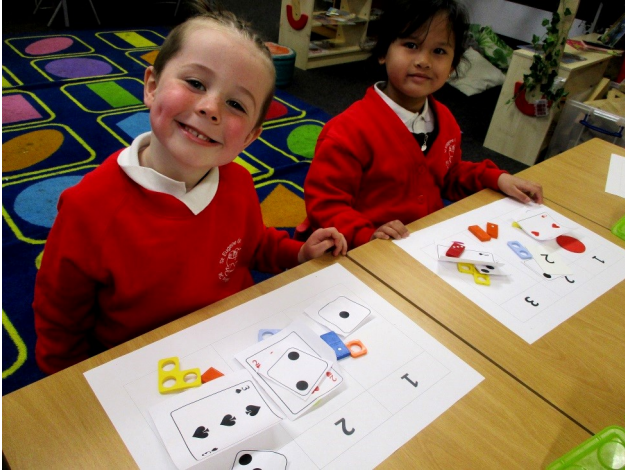


What have we been learning?

Week beginning: 11th November 2024

This week in maths we have been exploring the numbers 1 2 and 3. We looked at different ways of representing each number—the numeral, numicon, objects, dice patterns, domino patterns, playing cards, we also used our fingers to count and our hands to clap 1, 2 or 3 times. We then got a box of items representing either 1, 2, or 3 to sort. We have also been looking at different ways to make 2 and 3—e.g. $1+1=2$, $2+1=3$, $1+1+1=3$. We have also been learning about finding 1 more and 1 less.



We have been learning all about fireworks and bonfire night this week. We have been learning some new words to describe the sounds of fireworks. Ask your child what these words are and what the action is :)

How can you help your child with their learning?

- Help your child to learn to read their tricky words by using the flashcards in the homework pack. Say the words in silly voices and ask them to repeat the words, put the words into sentences, read them together, you could even stick them on the fridge! It is important that your child knows these words to help them read books fluently.
- Please read your child's new sound blending books with them and help them to complete their homework. Your child's sound blending books are to help your child practise reading words. Ask them to sound out the word and check on the next page to see if the picture matches the word.
- Our topic for the next week is birthdays. Please discuss with your child when their birthday is and speak to them about different ways that you celebrate their birthday.
