

What have we been learning?

Week beginning: 23rd September 2024

This week we have started our phonics lessons, which is the beginning of being able to read. We have learned the sounds 'm' and 'a'. We will learn all of our letter sounds and how to write them, and then we will learn how to blend the sounds together to read words. We have all been working very hard!



In RE this week, we spoke about our names and why they are important. We sang to every child and said hello. We learned that God knows we are all special, and that he knows all of our names and loves us very much. We learned names of familiar adults in our school, and what their job is. We played our class game 'Who's Behind The Door', looking through a book with a different child behind each door to practice learning each others names.



How can you help your child with their learning?

- Help your child to recognise their name, and practise writing their name. Make sure they begin with a capital letter, but all other letters are lower case.
- Please read with your child every day. Reading for just 15 minutes each day is the single most important thing you can do to help your child's learning. Your child will bring home new reading books every week.
- Speak to your child about their name, why you chose it, and how they are so special :)
