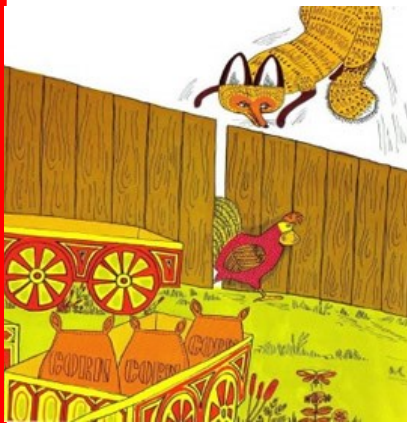


What have we been learning?

Week beginning: 15th July 2024

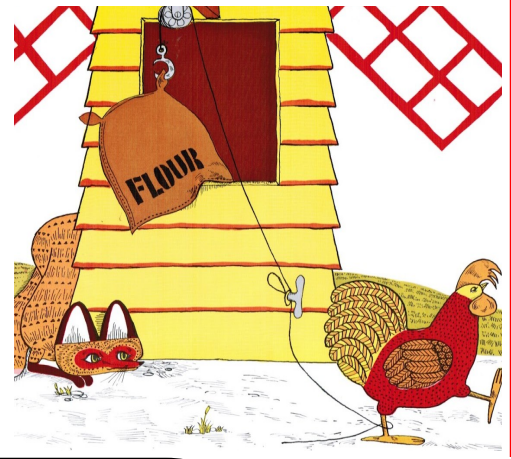
This week we have been reading the book 'Rosie's Walk'. We have been writing our own retells of the story using prepositional language—this tells us how Rosie the hen got to each place.



Rosie went **through** the fence.



Rosie went **over** the haystack.



Rosie went **past** the mill.



In maths, we have been making maps to show how to get to different places. We have made maps for Rosie's Walk, The Little Red Riding Hood, and our journey to school.

Little Red Riding Hood started at home, went past some trees, a pond, some flowers and then a big tall tree. Then she got to Grandma's house.



How can you help your child with their learning?

- Make a map with your child of a familiar route e.g. home to school. Add in landmarks such as parks, train stations, shops. Your child can bring it in to show the class :)
- Describe the position of objects/people using the words under, over, through, behind, next to, past, across and around.
