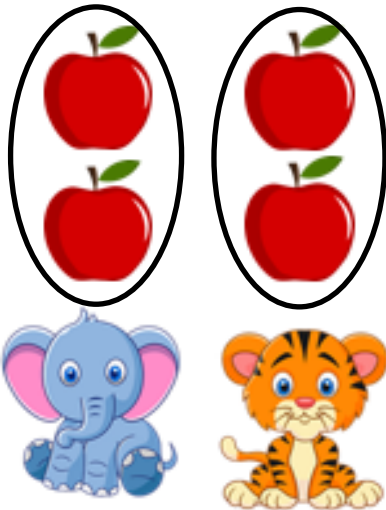


# What have we been learning?

In maths we have been learning to share equally. This is the beginning of learning how to divide. We have been learning to make sure that each person has the same amount of objects. We then know that the objects have been shared equally.

## How can you help your child with their learning?

- Please help your child with their letter formation homework. It is important that they start at the top of the letter, their letters are neat, facing the right way, and sitting in the right place on the line.
- Talk to your child about different types of journeys and transport. Discuss long journeys, which may need a train or bus, or a short journey, which you could walk or cycle to. Talk about past journeys and experiences that you have had together.
- Please do keep reading with your child every day. Reading for just 15 minutes each day is the single most important thing you can do to help your child's learning.
