

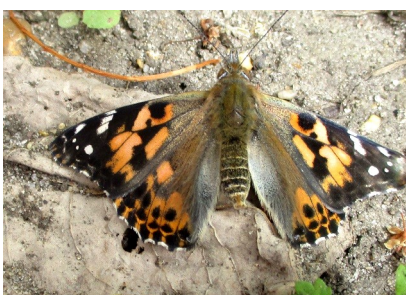
# What have we been learning?

Week beginning: 3rd June 2024

This week we have been learning about Road Safety. We have learned a song that tells us to STOP, LOOK, LISTEN AND THINK before we cross a road. We spoke about how important it is that we hold an adults hand when crossing the road. We went out for a walk in small groups and practised crossing normal roads, then using a puffin crossing and a zebra crossing to help us cross the busier roads safely. We also made our own road map in class, and practised crossing a zebra crossing and a puffin crossing in the playground.



Our beautiful butterflies finally hatched over the half term! When we got back on Monday, they were ready to fly. We enjoyed watching them fly away on their new adventure.



## How can you help your child with their learning?

- Please help your child with their letter formation homework. It is important that their letters are neat, facing the right way, and sitting in the right place on the line.
- Practise crossing the road safely with your child, encouraging them to stop, look, listen and think every time they cross a road. Discuss with your child when it is safe to cross, and when it is not safe to cross the road.
