On Tuesday we attended mass to celebrate the feast of St Eugene. We learned lots and enjoyed singing with the rest of our school :)



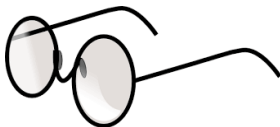

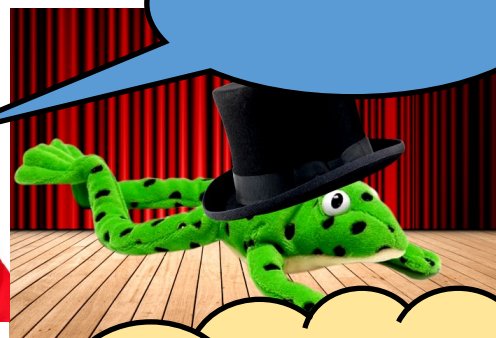
